Please be advised that the law firm of Craig Kelley & Faultless LLC, has been retained by the above-referenced client(s) as legal counsel in a personal injury action. It has come to our attention that the State of Indiana, the Indiana Department of Transportation, Morgan County, and/or the City of Martinsville are, or may be, responsible for all or a portion of the damages and injuries sustained by my client(s). Pursuant to Indiana Code § 34-13-3-10, the following is a short and plain statement of the facts upon which the claim is based.

THE CIRCUMSTANCES WHICH BROUGHT ABOUT THE LOSS.

On June 17, 2026, at approximately 9:51 a.m., Pamela Hampton, was involved in a crash at the intersection of State Road 142 and Wilbur Road in Morgan County. The other people that appear to have been involved in the crash are Andrew Wehring and Tanner Dickerson. I am including a copy of the Indiana Officer's Standard Crash Report.

The roadway at or near the scene of the collision may have been dangerous or unsafe.

THE EXTENT OF THE LOSS.

As a result of the collision, my client sustained fatal injuries and was pronounced dead at the scene.

Howard Hampton and Eric Hampton have lost the love and companionship of the their mother, Pamela Hampton.

Narrative

The following was written by LONG, JEREMY

Vehicle 1 was traveling north on Wilbur Rd. Vehicle 2 was traveling east on SR 142. According to several witnesses, Vehicle 1 did not stop at the posted stop sign for the intersection and continued to travel northbound across the roadway. Witnesses also advised that Vehicle 2 was seen slamming on the brakes and honking the horn trying to alert Driver 1 before hitting Vehicle 1 in the driver's door. One witness did state that she believed Vehicle 1 to stop at the stop sign prior to entering the intersection. Roadway evidence does corroborate that Vehicle 2 applied the brakes heavily and even introduced steering to try and avoid contact. Other roadway evidence shows that Vehicle 1 made an attempt to turn to the left. It is uncertain whether Vehicle 1 was attempting to turn westbound onto SR 142, or if Driver 1 turned the wheel to the left upon seeing Vehicle 2 in an attempt to avoid contact. Driver 1 was pronounced deceased on scene and the Morgan County Serious Crash Team was contacted to investigate the crash. Vehicle 1 was towed to Curtis Garage and Vehicle 2 was towed to a residence at the owner's request of Mooresville Towing. Driver 2 was taken for a blood draw to satisfy the Indiana Implied Consent for a Serious Bodily Injury or Fatality Crash. A full reconstruction narrative will be available upon completion in the Morgan County Sheriff's Office reporting system.

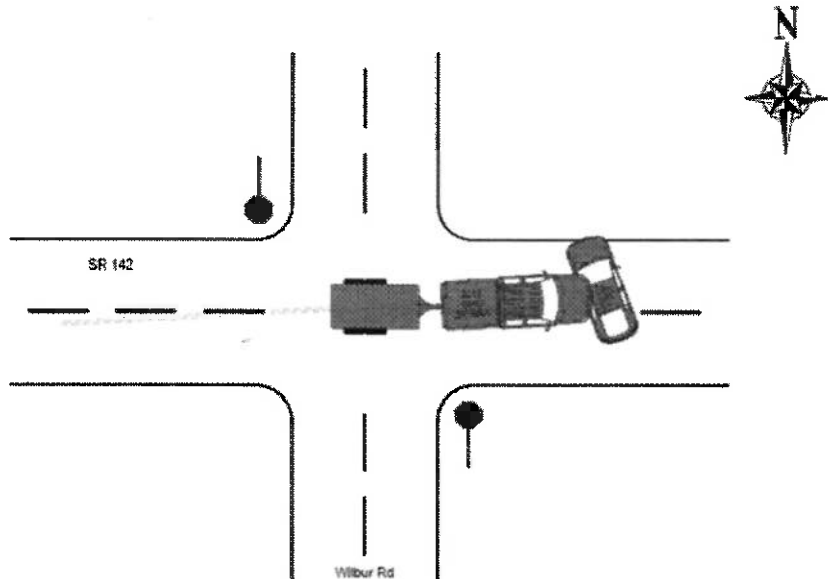
